Each proposal must be accompanied by a bid bond in the form of a Corporate Surety Bond, Certified Check, Cashiers Check or Certificate of Deposit in the amount of \$5,000.00, a signed proposal, and signed anti-collusion affidavit.

GENERAL BIDDING REQUIREMENTS

- 1. All bids must be made on the proposal form furnished by the City. No bid will be considered unless the Proposal Form and Anti-Collusion Affidavit are properly signed.
- 2. The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids, and to waive defects in the form of the bid, also to select the bid which best meets the requirements of the City.
- 3. Each proposal must be accompanied by a bid bond sent in the form of a Corporate Surety Bond, Certified Check, Certificate of Deposit, or Cashiers Check in the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00). The City will accept a certified check, or cashiers check in place of a bond. Failure to submit the above will result in immediate rejection.
- 4. The City of Erie will not waive or permit any type of bonding etc, to be submitted after the bid opening. Failure to submit proper bonding with bid documents will result in immediate rejection of bid. All Bids will be firm for sixty (60) days from date of bid opening. All bids will be firm for one (1) year from date of signing of Contract, unless otherwise specified.
- 5. Any discounts or terms must be shown on the proposal form. Such discounts, if any, will be computed and considered in tabulating of the bids.
- 6. All bids shall be in the hands of the city Purchasing Department Room 309, 626 State Street, Erie, PA. 16501-1128 PA. by the time and date mentioned in the "LEGAL NOTICE", and shall be placed in a sealed envelope plainly marked with; THE DATE AND TIME OF RECEIPT OF BIDS; THE BID NUMBER PLAINLY MARKED ON THE ENVELOPE: THE ITEM FOR WHICH THE BIDDER IS SUBMITTING THE BID; AND THE BIDDER'S COMPANY NAME AND RETURN ADDRESS.
- 7. The City is not liable for non-receipt of bids sent by ordinary mail, nor if delivered in person to any other City employee or Office other than the City Purchasing Office. Late deliveries of bids will not be considered.
- 8. The City of Erie is not subject to the Pennsylvania Sales Tax, and to most Federal Excise Taxes on all sales made directly to the city and neither should be included in bid price. Tax exemption certificates will be furnished and signed by the city purchasing department, for the successful bidder.
- 9. Tangible personal property purchased by Contractors in the performance of realty construction for the City of Erie is taxable, even though the City is exempt on its own purchases.
- 10. In case of two or more identical bids tying as low bid, the City of Erie reserves the right to select in its own discretion from among such identical bidders, (1) one bid which will be awarded the total contract.

- 11. Any transportation, fees and/or any other related charges incurred in pick up, deliver, and/or processing of the product, as specified, must be included in the bid price for the duration of the contract.
- 12. The successful bidder shall have and maintain, at its own expense all licenses, registrations, permits and authorization necessary for the receiving, delivery, processing and disposal of the specified service for the awarded contract period. The successful bidder shall also pay all fees and charges incurred in maintaining its licenses, registrations, permits and authorizations necessary to conduct its business including all additional fees and charges imposed during the awarded contract period.
- 13. Successful bidder shall pay all federal, state, city and local taxes, fines, penalties, fees and assessments arising pursuant to the contract and shall adhere to all requirements of the constituted public authorities and with all federal, state and local laws and ordinance and the applicable rules, regulations, methods and procedures of all governmental boards, bureaus, offices, commissions and other agencies now or hereafter in effect.
- 14. Payment will be made by the city within thirty (30) days from receipt and acceptance, by the city, of delivery of COMPLETE ORDERS OF BID ITEMS or receipt of invoice for same, whichever is received the later.
- 15. The successful bidder at its own cost and expense, shall obtain and maintain in full force insurance coverage which will satisfactorily insure the bidder and the City of Erie against all claims and liabilities which could arise out of the contract including, but not limited to, claims and liabilities for the injury (including death) or damage to persons and property which could arise during the duration of the awarded contract. The City Of Erie will be named as additional insured.
- 16. Bidder will be required to submit evidence satisfactory to the City Purchasing Agent that the various bonds and insurance, as outlined in these documents, have been obtained. Such evidence will be required within ten (10) days of the awarding of the contract. Failure to submit said evidence shall be deemed to be a material breach of the contract.
- 17. Bidders shall not discriminate against any person employed or seeking employment with the bidder because of race, color, creed, sex or national origin and shall comply with all applicable ordinances, statutes and regulations of the City of Erie, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or Federal Government relating to Equal Employment Opportunity.
- 18. All bidders must comply with all regulations as documented by Pennsylvania Statutes, Title 73 Trade and Commerce regarding Chapter 25, Steel Products Procurement Act #1881 to 1887.

- 19. All bidders must comply with all regulations as documented by Pennsylvania Statutes, Title 73 Trade and Commerce regarding Chapter 25A, Motor Vehicle Procurement Act #1891 to 1898.
- 20. The City of Erie reserves the right to terminate this contract for any reason with thirty (30) days written notices to the contract holder.

21. PLEASE RETURN BID DOCUMENT IN ITS ENTIRETY.

- 22. Brand names, specific companies, manufacturing concerns, contact names, etc., that may be referred to in these specifications are to be considered as references only, bidders can utilize any source at their disposal to obtain information for their bids.
- 23. All errors in calculations shall be corrected and the City of Erie shall deem the corrected totals official.
- 24. The successful bidder shall pay all applicable royalties and licenses fees. The Successful bidder warrants that the sale or use of products and/or services shall not infringe on any United States or foreign patent. The successful bidder undertakes to indemnify the City of Erie against all judgments, decrees, costs and expenses, including attorney's fees, resulting from any alleged infringement and to defend, upon request of the City of Erie, at its own expense, any action which may be brought against the City of Erie under any claim of patent infringement in the use or sale of the successful bidder's products and/or services.
- 25. If any provisions of the contract are found to be illegal or unenforceable, then, notwithstanding such provision, the contract shall remain in full force and effect and such offensive provision shall be deemed stricken.
- 26. The awarded contract shall be governed by the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- 27. Successful bidder shall be current for all City Of Erie taxes, fines, and assessments.

<u>SPECIFICATIONS</u>

These Specifications are intended to provide the information by which prospective bidders may understand the requirements of the City of Erie relative to furnishing and delivering of uniforms, shoes and miscellaneous items listed on the proposal form for the City of Erie, Bureau of Police.

<u>GUARANTEE</u>: Vendor shall be required to re-work, re-alter, or replace garments failing inspection with one (1) week from date of delivery by the vendor. All uniform and equipment's items shall carry a full manufactures warranty.

<u>AWARDS</u>: Awards shall be based solely on the discretion of City of Erie relative to its judgement to split this bid or to award to single vendor. Material, design, price, and other differences in bid items shall be a determining factor in award selection(s).

<u>MATERIALS</u>: Clothing materials shall be as indicated in these specifications, any exceptions must be noted or proposal shall be rejected. The City shall be the sole judge in accepting or rejecting all exceptions.

<u>COMPLIANCE</u>: Bidders must comply with all City of Erie requirements related to this bid.

TO ALL BIDDERS

- 1. Bidders are required to provide firm pricing for the pricing for the period of May 2006 through April 2008. The City of Erie reserves the right to extend this contract for an additional one (1) year period (May 2008 through April 2009) provided the City has received, in writing, a request from the successful bidder for an extension, and the prices remain in effect for the additional period. The City of Erie will make the final decision to extend the contract.
- 2. All shirts, jackets, coveralls, etc., which require emblems (#1-001) must contain emblem cost and attachment of same included with garment price.
- 3. All bidders must submit a sample of one (1) shirt #4-001, one (1) shirt #4-004, one (1) shirt #4-005, one (1) trouser #3-001, one (1) trouser #3-007, one (1) winter jacket #2-002, one (1) duty belt #10-001, and any other item that might be requested by the City. Samples shall be adequately identified with bidder name and specification number. Items will be returned by the Purchasing Office upon inspection review of such. Bidder must note any exception to specifications of any item on proposal. The City of Erie shall make the decision to accept or reject any exception.
- 4. Bidder shall have adequate inventory and staff to meet the requirements of the City of Erie. All orders shall be properly packaged and shipped promptly.
- 5. SPECIAL CONSIDERATION SHALL BE GIVEN LOCAL VENDORS WHO MAINTAIN AN "ON HAND" INVENTORY OF POLICE ITEMS, HAVE CONVENIENT OPERATING HOURS, PROFESSIONAL FITTING SERVICE, AND UNIFORM ALTERATION AVAILABILITY.
- 6. Successful vendor shall be required to have computerized record keeping of uniform allowance spent by members. This information must be electronically transmitted to the department on a monthly basis:

Employee
Unit Cost per Item
Total Cost on Order
Total Cost To-Date

In addition, database should be able to track total cost of all orders, total cost of all items currently invoiced and total of all paid invoices, including the balance remaining on each employee's allowance.

This information must be updated weekly and available through an electronic link with the departments.

The following computer accessible capabilities are preferred, but not required.

- -Ability to submit employee uniform requisitions via electronic linkup.
- -Ability to review current uniform specifications and prices.
- 7. The City of Erie reserves the right to terminate such contract or agreement at any time due to lack of vendor performance in regards to quality, service, workmanship, warranty, late deliveries, etc.
- 8. All freight, packaging or shipping charges shall be included in the price for each item bid. Bidder is totally responsible for any returned garment or article. Freight also applies.
- 9. Bidder is responsible for proper measurement and fit of all new officers. This includes equipment and uniforms. Fitting shall be done in Room 309 of the Municipal Building or at the facility of the successful bidder. Fitting appointments must be made available within one week of notice to bidder.
- 10. The City of Erie reserves the right to award such contract or agreement to one vendor or multiple vendors.
- 11. All bidders shall present at bid opening a bid bond in the amount of \$5,000.00. The City will accept a certified check, cashiers check, in place of a bond. Failure to submit the above will result in immediate rejection.
