GENERAL QUALIFICATIONS

ORDERING PROCESS and PROGRAM ADMINISTRATION:

Vendor to provide service award recipients with a letter of introduction with gift selection communication. Vendor to provide multiple service award ordering options including telephone, fax, and on-line availability. Vendor to provide on-line program administration ability to Rockwood School District service award program administrator.

DELIVERY:

Vendor agrees to ship products ordered per the delivery dates established on the signed bid agreement. Failure to meet these contractual dates shall result in a penalty of 1% per calendar day, to be deducted from the final invoice.

INSPECTION:

All products furnished and delivered under the contract shall be subject to inspection by Rockwood School District. If any items or articles are found not to meet the requirements of the specification, the lot, or any faulty portion thereof, they may be rejected. GUARANTEE:

Should an award piece become damaged, except by deliberate means, the same will be refurbished, or replaced free of charge.
