- 5) Your bid must be placed inside a **SEALED** envelope, an identified by the NAME OF THE FIRM, NAME AND NUMBER OF THE BID ALONG WITH THE DATE AND TIME OF BID OPENING. Failure to do do is cause to reject your bid.
