- 1. In order for a proposal to be considered, it must be based on terms, conditions and scope of services contained herein and must be a complete response to this RFP. One (1) original and two (2) copies of each Proposal including a digital soft copy (on CD or stick) of your response in PDF format readable on Microsoft Operating systems shall be submitted to the Issuing Department. The original Proposal should be marked "Original". The copies must consist of all documents that are included in the "Original" Proposal. No other distribution of the Proposal shall be made by the Proposer. Proposals shall be limited to fifteen (15) double-sided pages or less and must be signed by an authorized representative. Each Proposal should be bound in a single volume with all relevant documentation. The Town may elect to require oral presentations after receipt of the proposals.
- 2. **PRE-PROPOSAL CONFERENCE:** A Pre-Proposal Conference will be held at 11:00 A.M., on Wednesday, May 29, 2019, located in the Public Utilities Conference Room, 230 Hospital Road, Smithfield, North Carolina 27577. The purpose of this Conference is to allow all potential proposers an opportunity to present questions and obtain clarifications relative to this solicitation. While attendance at this Conference will not be a prerequisite to submitting a proposal, all potential Proposers are strongly encouraged to attend and read the entire solicitation in advance. Any changes resulting from this Conference will be issued in a written Addendum to the solicitation.
- 3. <u>COMMUNICATION WITH PROPOSERS:</u> All communications between the Public Utilities Department and prospective proposers shall be in writing. Questions and responses affecting the Scope of Services will be provided to all Proposers by issuance of an Addendum. All questions shall be received by the Public Utilities Department no later than 3:00 P.M., on June 6, 2019. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 4. **PROPOSAL DUE DATE:** Proposals will be received until 2:00 P.M., on June 13, 2019. Proposals must be mailed or hand delivered to: Town of Smithfield Public Utilities Department, Attn: Ted Credle 230 Hospital Road, Smithfield, NC 27577. Proposals shall be duly marked and/or identified with Proposer name, address and RFP number.
  - **LATE PROPOSALS:** Proposals received after the date and time specified will not be considered for award and will be returned to the Proposer unopened.
- 5. **VENDOR APPLICATION:** All Proposers shall complete and submit the Vendor Application along with the W-9 Form. This information will be used to create or update the Town's electronic vendor database upon award of contract.
- 6. **BOND REQUIREMENTS:** A Performance Bond will not be required for this project.
- 7. **INVOICE PAYMENT:** Invoices submitted will be paid net 30 days. Invoices shall be forwarded to the Town's Designated Representative for review and payment approval.
- 8. <u>TERMS OF CONTRACT:</u> The term of the contract will be from **July 1, 2019** through **October 31, 2019**Any renewal, or extension, of service shall be based on satisfactory performance by the Contractor(s) during the initial term of services provided. Price increases may be negotiated only at time of renewal.
- 9. CANCELLATION OF CONTRACT: The Town of Smithfield reserves the right to cancel and terminate any resulting contract(s), in part or in whole, without penalty, upon 30 days written notice to the Contractor. Any contract cancellation shall not relieve the Contractor(s) of the obligation to deliver and/or perform services on all outstanding orders issued prior to the effective date of cancellation.

# SURVEY OF DURWOOD STEPHENSON ROAD – PHASE 2 FOR TOWN OF SMITHFIELD WATER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM

#### SCOPE OF SERVICES

This Scope of Services will become an integral part of the contract between the Town of Smithfield and the Contractor. The Contractor hereby agrees to provide services and/or materials to the Town pursuant to the provisions set forth below.

- 1.0 **PURPOSE:** The purpose and intent of the Request for Proposals (RFP) is to solicit proposals from qualified firms to provide Land Surveying and Underground Utility Location services. The selected contractor is to identify and survey approximately 3,600 linear feet of roadway, and associated right-of-way; beginning approximately 400 feet west of the bridge spanning the Neuse River and continuing along with the bridge and right-of-way of Durwood Stephenson Road to a fire hydrant approximately 400 feet east of the aforementioned bridge. The contractor will produce a map, suitable to be the basis of engineering design, in AutoCAD format, and an electronic copy of all data collected.
- 2.0 **BACKGROUND:** The Town desires a contractor to perform these land surveying services to create a "base map" for the design of a plan & profile for a water line to be installed along the northern right-of-way of Durwood Stephenson Road.

4.0 **WORK REQUIREMENTS:** The Contractor is to physically survey the length of approximately 3,600 linear feet of roadway, to create a surveyed "base map" for the creation of an engineered design to construct a water line along the northern right-of-way of Durwood Stephenson Road.

The land survey will consist of horizontal and vertical location of the existing asphalt road; the NCDOT right-of-way; ; the NCDOT bridge; any above ground structures; any existing utilities; the location of the existing NCDOT animal fence; and the approximation of the woods line along the northern right-of-way. Contractor will locate in reference to NAD 83, as the reference coordinate geometry.

The Contractor will also perform a "Level C" survey of subsurface utilities in the same corridor as previously described.

A set of Town Utility system maps will be given to the contractor at the onset of the contract, to assist in this endeavor.

The deliverable to the Town will be a thumb drive, disk, or set of disks; containing the surveyed data in ".DWG", ".GDB", and ".SHP" file format.

The Contractor will be given 60 days to complete the work and submit the deliverable.

5.0 **SCHEDULES/TIMELINES:** The term of the contract is from July 1, 2019 through October 30, 2019. The Contractor will be given 60 days to complete the work described and submit the deliverable. Any renewal of services shall be based on satisfactory performance by the Contractor(s) during the initial term.



### **OUALIFICATIONS AND SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

The Proposal must include all of the information set forth in this Section and other Sections of this RFP and should be organized and tabbed appropriately. Unnecessary elaborate brochures or other materials beyond those sufficient to present a complete and effective response to this solution are not desired and may be construed as an indication of the Proposer's lack of cost consciousness.
