- 1. Will this contract be used on the FL State DOT roads within Jackson County? no
- 2. If the answer to question 2 is Yes, does the County and its municipalities have a preexisting memorandum of understanding with FL DOT that authorizes them to perform the debris removal services on state roads? no
- 3. Regarding the evaluation of the Pricing, does the County intend on adding up all unit price line items to get a total figure to compare against other proposer's or will there be quantities assigned? If quantities are going to be assigned, what will they be? We will be comparing each line item, no quantities will be assigned
- 4. Regarding the evaluation of the hourly pricing, how does the County intend on weighing the hourly line items? Are quantities going to be assigned, if so what will they be? We will be comparing each line item, no quantities will be assigned
- 5. How will the hourly pricing schedule be weighted in comparison to the unit price schedule to split the 10% pricing evaluation criteria? All pricing will be evaluated per line item. The total weight for pricing is 10 points
- 6. Can you please provide the names and titles of the evaluation committee members? The Board of Commissioners will serve as the ranking committee.
- 7. Please provide the date, time and location when the evaluation committee meeting will be held to evaluate proposals? Undetermined, evaluation committee meeting will only be held of deemed absolutely necessary
- 8. Where will the evaluation committee meeting notice be posted? undetermined
- 9. When will intent to award be made and how will it be communicated to proposers? December 10, 2019 Regular Board Meeting, all vendors will be notified via email.
- 10.For Tab C Financial Information, is the proposer required to provide their financial information with the proposal or, may it be requested by the County at a later date? Proposer shall submit the financial information with the original proposal.
- 11.Page 4 of the RFP requests one (1) electronic copy in PDF format on CD be supplied with our proposal. Is it acceptable to the County if a USB Flash Drive is used instead of a CD? Yes

- 12.Page 21 asks for our proposal to be spiral bound, is spiral binding mandated or may we substitute with 3-ring binders? Spiral binding is recommended but not required.
- 13. Can you provide the location of your TDSRS(s)? undetermined at this time.
- 14.Page 29 of the RFP reads as follows: "Removal of Eligible Hazardous Trees and Limbs Work consists of removing Eligible hazardous trees and limbs and placing them on the safest possible location on the County ROW for collection under the terms and conditions of Element 1, Eligible ROW Vegetative Debris Removal." However, the title for that portion of work on the pricing schedule is "Tree Operations, Including Hauling". Could you please clarify whether the payment for Hazardous Trees and Limbs will include hauling? Yes, it would include haling to the DMS
- 15.Pg. 21, Tab E, asks proposers to for a "list of costs associated with personnel with your proposal."
 - a. Does this mean that the County wants the last page of the Unit Cost Fee Rate Schedule to be included in Tab E? No
 - b. If not, please clarify. I is not necessary to list the cost here if all cost are included on the fee schedule.
- 16. Pg. 23, evaluation criteria, lists two points of criteria (Company/Firm/Key Principal Qualifications and Capabilities and Qualifications and Abilities of Professional Personnel) that do not have a designated place within the proposal format (pg. 21-22). Include this information under Tab B
- 17. Waterway Debris Removal Line item Does the County anticipate this work to be performed as marine-based operations or land-based operations? If the answer is both, will the County consider adding a line item (one for land-based and one for marine based) to the bid sheet? This has been added to the revised fee schedule (see attached)
- 18.Please confirm that we are to write "Pass-Through" as the unit cost for Tipping Fees found in the Final Disposal Section of the Rate Schedule. This is also addressed on the revised fee schedule
- 19. Will the County consider changing the unit of measure for Bottled Water, Palletized Truck Load for \$/Pound to \$/Case? changed on revised fee schedule
- 20. The following changes have been made to the fee schedule (see attached copy of revised fee schedule)
 - A. Private Property Debris Removal, from Private Property to DMS to be priced by the Cubic Yard
 - B. Private Property Hazards Tree Removal To be priced per Tree and broken in to tree size categories
 - C. Private Property Hazardous Limb Removal Priced per Tree
 - D. Private Property Hazardous Stump Removal To be priced per stump and broken in to stump size categories
 - E. "Demolition of private structures" has been changed to two categories: Non Asbestos and Asbestos
 - F. "Waterway Debris Removal" has been changed to two categories: Land Based Operation and Water Based Operations.
