County Road 167 (Fairview Road) Signage & Pavement Marking

The project consists of signing and pavement marking improvements on CR 167 (Fairview Road) from Calhoun County Line to CR 276 (Kynesville Road). The work includes MOT in accordance with FDOT Standards, placement of signing, removal of existing pavement markings, standard thermoplastic pavement markings, profiled thermoplastic pavement markings (audible/vibratory warning), raised pavement markers and other as indicated in the bid documents and plans.

A Pre-Bid Meeting will not be held. The deadline for receipt of questions will be June 11, 2020 at 1:00 PM Central Time. Bids will be opened and recorded at 1:10 PM (or immediately thereafter) on June 18, 2020 at the Jackson County Board of County Commissioners Board Room at 2864 Madison Street. Bids may also be submitted to the Public Transportation Director, Scotty Taylor at the Board Room from 12:40 PM until 1:00 PM Central Time.

Plans, specifications, and contract documents will be open for public inspection after 12:00 PM on May 26, 2020 at the Jackson County Emergency Operations Center, 2819 Panhandle Rd, Marianna, FL 32446. Bid documents must be obtained from www.jacksoncountyfl.net and select Current Bids/RFP's or by sending an email request to jbean@jacksoncountyfl.com or by phone at (850) 693-1878. There is No Charge per set for the bid documents.

The Owner reserves the right to waive any informality or to reject any or all bids. Each Bidder must deposit with his/her bid, security in the amount, form and subject to the conditions provided in the Information for Bidders. Sureties used for obtaining bonds must appear as acceptable according to the Department of Treasury Circular 570. Bidders must be Pre-approved by FDOT or Jackson County and in good standing with FDOT and the County.

No bid may be withdrawn for a period of sixty days after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids.

To the extent applicable to this project, attention of Bidders is particularly called to the requirements of the Special Provisions, conditions of employment to be observed, and minimum wage rates to be paid under the Contract (if applicable), Section 3, Segregated Facilities, Section 109 Executive Order 11246, and all applicable laws and regulations of the Federal government and State of Florida, and bonding and insurance requirements.

Minorities and female contractors and subcontractors are encouraged to bid.
