



C. Recording Confirmation

The applicant shall record this document in accordance with General Condition 8 of the Order of Conditions (see below), complete the form attached to this Extension Permit, have it stamped by the Registry of Deeds, and return it to the Conservation Commission.

Note: General Condition 8 of the Order of Conditions requires the applicant, prior to commencement of work, to record the final Order (or in this case, the Extension Permit for the Order of Conditions) in the Registry of Deeds or the Land Court for the district in which the land is located, within the chain of title of the affected property. In the case of recorded land, it shall be noted in the Registry's Granter Index under the name of the owner of the land upon which the proposed work is to be done. In the case of registered land, it shall also be noted on the Land Court Certificate of Title of the owner of the land upon which the proposed work is done.

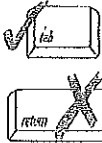

Special Order of Conditions

NOI 205-312

- 1 No plastic bags are to be left in the fields.
- 2 Trash receptacles to be provided in the drop-off area.
- 3 Leaves to be dropped off only in areas specified by the DPW.
- 4 Leaves must be tilled into the soil by January 1 of each year.
- 5 Prior to the start of the leaf collection season the DPW must review the plans for the coming season with the Conservation Commission to include hours of collection, signage to be erected and staffing.
- 6 The DPW file number sign must be displayed in the major drop-off area and kept clear of vegetation to be legible at all times.
- 7 A portable toilet is to be provided for the staff at the drop-off area.
- 8 If the alternate drop-off area needs to be used because of inclement weather, the Conservation Commission is to be notified at 567-4100 ext. 1323. On weekends, notify the Conservation Chairman at 567-9016.
- 9 Land elevation to be surveyed annually and reported to the Conservation Commission.
- 10 Water quality of the test wells are to be tested each spring and fall and reported to the Conservation Commission.
- 11 The Order of Conditions is valid for five years from the date of issue.
